UPDATE ON THE MATS FOR THE HOMELESS PROJECT

This is a good project to work on during this time of quarantine. We have nine mats ready to be delivered, with 5 people continuing to crochet. Please remember, even if you don't crochet you can participate by donating plastic bags (please hold on to them for the time being) and making plarn.

Refresher in making plarn: Smooth out the plastic bags, it usually works well to stack about 5 at a time, cut off the tops and the bottom, fold over (the long way) about 3 times and then cut in three-inch blocks. Join the strips and roll them into a big ball, about the size of a soccer ball. The people crocheting really appreciate the balls of plarn. YouTube has detailed instructions for making mats for the homeless.

Going forward, instead of holding workshops we will join with the knitting group when they gather at 1:00 p.m. on the last Wed. of the month in the workroom at the church office. Join us (once the Safer-at-home ban has been lifted) for knitting, crocheting or the craft of your choice.





On Saturday and Sunday, May 9 and 10, we have a guest, Mr. Jeryes Qumseya, scheduled to speak. He will be speaking about the plight of Christians living in Palestine. Jeryes leads Blest Art, an organization in Beloit that supports Christians living in Palestine. Due to violence that keeps erupting in the Holy Land, the tourism industry has dwindled and is at an all-time low, especially in Bethlehem.

Christians living in Palestine depend on tourism as their only source of income. As a result, Palestinian Christian emigration has increased. At one time, Christians made up more than 63% of the population of Palestine. Christians are now less than 1% of the total population in the Holy Land.

For centuries, Christians in the Holy Land have earned their living by carving religious art from olive wood they have pruned from trees in their family olive groves. Blest Art is dedicated to supporting these master artists and the Christian community in Palestine by creating jobs for needy fellow Christians and creating a more stable source of income for them.

Jeryes Qumseya will be bringing many of the carvings to sell in Fellowship Hall: statues, crosses, nativity sets, jewelry, and ornaments. If you would like to see what Blest Art has to offer, you can go to their website at www.BlestArt.com.
