



Do you recognize that phrase? It belongs to you.

Jesus gave us the Great Commission. He said, "Go and make disciples!" (Or "As you are going, disciple!" if you heard the sermon on August 9th!) Our United Methodist denomination created our denominational mission

statement: "Making disciples for the transformation of the world." Most churches personalize their own mission statement. Yours is "Loving people into their next steps with Jesus."


You can watch worship online in two ways: * On our church website
